When the legislative session came to a close on Thursday, lawmakers had failed to pass a budget both the House and Senate could agree on, so they will return in special session on Wednesday, Feb. 24 to try again.

Education Took A Beating in Both the House and Senate

Neither the House nor the Senate was kind to public education during the regular session. The House passed a budget that cut \$133 million more in school funding over last year's budget. The Senate was even rougher, passing a budget that further slashed funding for our schools by \$233 million!
