

The PED wants to raise your licensure fees!

The NM Public Education Department proposes to raise the fees for obtaining a teaching license, renewing a license, and submitting a dossier to advance in licensure. The PED wants these increases to take effect on March 15, 2010.

Here's what is proposed:

<u>License Action</u>	<u>Current Fee</u>	<u>Proposed Fee</u>
Applying for NM Teaching License	\$ 65	\$125
Renewal of Teaching License	\$ 35	\$ 95
Submitting Dossier Fee	\$185	\$320
Resubmitting 1 Dossier Strand	\$ 65	\$110
Resubmitting 2 Dossier Strands	\$115	\$220
Resubmitting 3 Dossier Strands	\$165	\$320
